## WHY THE LANGUAGE EXPLORER CAMPS?



Campers will benefit from a unique and friendly nature-filled language and cultural immersion opportunity. They'll take an international journey, virtually, without ever leaving home.

Campers will be guided by native speaking certificated language teachers, language fluent interns, a Park Board Naturalist and assistant with a ratio of 1 adult to 8 campers.

Campers are separated into groups according to language fluency and age as they participate in days filled with games, craft activities, lots of music... all with an emphasis on nature education.

## BY WEEK'S END

Novice campers will become comfortable with basic target language vocabulary and expressions, plus the words and concepts unique to the Nature Center. Language experienced campers will enjoy advanced conversational skills in addition to the Nature Center dialog.

All campers will leave with an appreciation for the natural world, motivation to continue to improve world language skills and familiarity with Cincinnati's Chinese and German Sister Cities: Munich, Germany; Liuzhou, China; and New Taipei City, Taiwan.

## LOCATION

Language Explorer Camps are located at the Trailside Nature Center in Burnet Woods, 3400 Brookline Ave., Cincinnati, OH 45220. The newly refurbished Nature Center is nestled in a delightful natural setting conveniently located near UC in the heart of Clifton.
